NSF Current & Pending Support



Research investigators are required to report Current/Pending Support to funding agencies per the <u>NSF Proposal and Award</u> <u>Policy and Procedures Guide (PAPPG)</u>.

Approved formats for creating current & pending support are:

- <u>SciENcv</u> (Updated September 21, 2021) NSF has partnered with the National Institutes of Health (NIH) to use <u>SciENcv: Science Experts Network Curriculum Vitae</u> as an NSFapproved format for use in preparation of the current and pending support section of an NSF proposal. Adoption of a single, common researcher profile system for Federal grants reduces administrative burden for researchers. <u>SciENcv</u> will produce NSF-compliant PDF versions of the current & pending support format. Proposers must save these documents and submit them as part of their proposals via FastLane, Research.gov, or Grants.gov.

A table entitled, <u>NSF Pre-award and Post-award Disclosures Relating to the Biographical Sketch</u> and <u>Current and Pending Support</u>, has been developed to provide helpful reference information regarding pre-award and post-award disclosure information in the biographical sketch and current and pending support proposal sections. The table identifies where these disclosures must be provided in proposals as well as in project reports. A <u>set of frequently asked questions related to</u> <u>current and pending support</u> also is available.

Current and pending support information must be separately provided through use of an <u>NSF-approved format</u>, for each individual designated as senior personnel on the proposal. Current and pending support includes all resources made available to an individual in support of and/or related to all of his/her research efforts, regardless of whether or not they have monetary value. Current and pending support also includes in-kind contributions (such as office/laboratory space, equipment, supplies, employees, students. In-kind contributions not intended for use on the project/proposal being proposed also must be reported.

Current and pending support information must be provided for this project, for ongoing projects, and for any proposals currently under consideration from whatever source, irrespective of whether such support is provided through the proposing organization or is provided directly to the individual.

The total award amount for the entire award period covered (including indirect costs) must be provided, as well as the number of person-months (or partial person-months) per year to be devoted to the project by the individual.
