SCOPE:

This SOP addresses the sanitation of caging supplies performed by cage wash staff.

OBJECTIVE:

This SOP describes the procedures for handling caging and supplies in preparation for sanitizing, sterilizing, and storage.

INFORMATION:

Most Rutgers University animal facilities use a rack washer and/or a tunnel washer for sanitizing caging (NexGen cages, Techniplast cages, inserts, bottles, cage tops). See individual SOP by building for specific instructions of operation and maintenance of cage washer's

PROCEDURE:

Sanitation of Caging:

- Bring soiled cages cage components to the dirty side cage wash on a rack or a cart and push into the room.
- Dump the soiled bedding and feed into trash bags under a dumping station or an automatic disposal system (Garb-el, Matrix).
- Once the cage is empty of its' dirty contents, inspect the

cage for defects. Set aside any cages with cracks or safety hazards. Bring any defects to the attention of the facility supervisor.

- Stack soiled cages onto a cart or onto a rack.
- Handle biohazards per their individual disposal instructions and specific hazard SOP, then process as above.
- Once caging is prepared for sanitization, follow specific vivarium SOP's for the cage wash equipment.
- Once sanitization of caging supplies is complete, store like components together.
- Prepare caging following SOP # 3.03 Preparing of Rodent Caging

Hand Washing of Caging Components:

- Soak soiled cages (after dumping and scraping) in Quatricide PV-15 for 15 minutes.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- When dry, prepare caging following SOP # 3.03 Preparation of Rodent Caging.
- When handwashing is necessary, sanitation effectiveness will be verified using the ATP Bioluminescence System at least weekly.

Water Bottles:

- Place water bottles on carts, or in larger containers, and bring them to dirty cage wash.
- Place bottles in a bottle rack.
- Remove sipper tube from bottles and place in a stainless-steel wire basket.
- Turn bottles upside down and empty.

• Wash bottle rack and accessory baskets in cage washer or bottle washer as appropriate for the facility.

Miscellaneous Items- cage card holders, tunnels, igloos

- Place all miscellaneous items (items too small to wash on their own) in stainless-steel wire baskets to be washed.
- Fill baskets, cover and sanitize in the cage washer appropriate for the facility.
- Remove all sanitized items on the clean side.
